This is an application seeking condonation of delay of 36 days in filing the accompanying appeal.

Mr. Shivendra Swaroop, AAG, Haryana and Mr. Pritam Saini, Advocate accept notice on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2 and respondent No.3, respectively.

For the reasons set out in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed. Consequently, the delay that has occurred in filing the accompanying appeal is condoned.

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Learned counsel for the appellants submits that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the order and judgment, dated 03.03.2016, rendered by this court in RFA No.4694 of 2014 [**Tara Chand and others v. State of Haryana and others**] and other connected cases, vide which in the appeals arising out of the same acquisition this court had enhanced the compensation awarded to the claimant-land owners.

The factual position, as set out above, is not disputed by learned counsel for the respondents.

For, concededly the matter in issue is squarely covered by the decision rendered by this court in Tara Chand’s case (supra), the present appeal is disposed of in the same terms.
