Defendant No.1 is in regular second appeal against the concurrent findings of fact arrived at by the Courts below.

Plaintiff claiming to be daughter of Sukhdev Singh had filed a suit for injunction restraining the defendants from alienating the suit property i.e. house in any manner whatsoever.

Both the Courts below after appreciating the evidence decreed the suit filed by the plaintiff.

It is not disputed before me that the plaintiff-respondent has already filed a suit for possession. In this case, there was no issue on the title of the property as it was a simpliciter suit for injunction.

Since the suit for possession has already been filed, the parties would be free to contest the suit in accordance with law.

With these observations, this regular second appeal is disposed of.
