Even on the third call, none has put in appearance on behalf of the appellants.

On 27.10.2017, last opportunity was granted to the learned counsel for the appellants to argue the case. It is still further recorded that on the next date of hearing, the case shall be considered/decided irrespective of the fact whether the learned counsel for the appellants comes present to argue the case or not.

Despite this situation, learned counsel for the appellants has not come present to argue the case. It appears that he has lost his interest in this case.
