and affidavit of even date dated 15.2.2017 are permitted to be placed on record as Annexures A-1 and A-2, respectively.

Main case

Learned counsel for the appellants submits that let the instant appeal be disposed of, in terms of the compromise dated 15.2.2017 (Annexure A-1) and also the affidavit (Annexure A-2).

When the case came up for hearing on 21.3.2017, learned counsel for the respondents sought time, which was granted to him and the parties were directed to come present for today. However, none of the respondents has come present. Appellant No.2 is present in the Court.

Should there be any confusion between the parties, it is directed that the compromise-deed dated 15.2.2017 (Annexure A-1) shall form part of the decree and the parties thereto shall remain bound by the terms and conditions thereof.
