RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

When this case came up for hearing on 15.10.2015, following order was passed by this Court: -

“Learned DAG, Haryana submits that application filed by the appellant on 21.07.2015 for grant of CLU is under consideration and no final decision has been taken on that application.

It is a case where CLU was allowed to the appellant in the year 2005. However, there was dispute regarding the amount claimed by the defendants. The claimant has now deposited ₹11,20,245/-. It is submitted that this amount has been paid as charges claimed by the defendant-respondents, which are prevalent as on today.

In view of the above facts, defendant-respondents are directed to take decision on the application within four weeks and

apprise this Court, failing which, request of appellant to reopen the petrol pump of appellant, which has been closed under the orders of defendant-respondents, will be considered.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that he had been continuously making efforts to get appropriate instructions from the appellant as to whether anything survives in the present appeal or not, but nobody is coming forward on behalf of the appellant to pass appropriate instructions to him. He further submits that it seems that the matter has already been rendered infructuous and nothing survives to be decided at the hands of this Court. However, he seeks liberty to get the present appeal revived, if necessity arises.

In view of the abovesaid fair statement made by learned counsel for the appellant, present appeal is ordered to be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, however, with liberty as prayed for.
