Learned counsel for the appellant, on instructions from Shri Manjit Singh son of Bachitar Singh(deceased), who is present in Court, submits that in compliance of the order dated 19.10.2016 and order dated 17.01.2017 passed by this Court, appellants have vacated the suit property on 17.02.2017. He further submits that respondent-Pritam Singh would be at liberty to occupy the suit property and neither they would have claim thereto nor they would threaten the possession of the respondent/plaintiff-Pritam Singh.

Further, learned counsel for the appellants submits that once the appellants have already vacated the suit property and nothing remains in the present appeal to be argued on merits, he may be permitted to withdraw the instant appeal.

Permission is granted.
