DEEPU AND ANR VS STATE OF PUNJAB AND ORS

The file has been put up by the Registry.

A perusal of the file shows that it is a case of run away couple, who had sought protection to their life and liberty. This Court vide order dated 31.05.2013 directed petitioner No.2 to deposit a sum of ₹1,00,000/- in the form of FDRs for a period of three years in favour of petitioner No.1 in two installments. First FDR was to be prepared before the adjourned date i.e. 06.06.2013 and the second FDR was to be prepared within nine months thereafter and the case was adjourned. In part compliance of the said order on 10.06.2013, petitioner No.2 had placed on record the copy of first FDR amounting of ₹50,000/- in favour of petitioner No.1 and the petition was disposed of by this Court.

The office has reported that there is no information as to whether the remaining amount of ₹50,000/- in the form of FDR in favour of petitioner No.1 was deposited or not?

Since it is a case of run away couple, therefore, the order dated 31.05.2013 stands recalled and the condition for the depositing of remaining amount of ₹50,000/- in the shape of FDR is waived off. No further direction is required in CRM-M No.19091 of 2013.
