RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

When the case came up for hearing on 10.05.2017, following order was passed by this Court: -

“Learned counsel for the appellant sought and was granted time to bring on record the legal representatives of respondent No.2 vide order dated 30.03.2016. However, nothing has been done so far and learned proxy counsel seeks more time.

Although there is no justification in adjourning the case any further, yet in the interest of justice, one last and final opportunity is granted to the appellant to bring on record the legal representatives of respondent No.2, however, subject to payment of Rs.5,000/- as costs, to be deposited by learned counsel for the appellant with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Committee.

Neither the abovesaid order has been complied with nor the costs have been paid. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that despite making the best efforts on her part, no instructions have been passed on to her by the appellant, who does not seem to be interested in pursuing the appeal any further. She expresses her inability to assist the Court and to press this appeal.

In view of the above, instant appeal is dismissed as not pressed and also for non-compliance of the abovesaid order passed by this Court.
