When the case came up for hearing on 16.2.2016, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Counsel for the appellant prays for an adjournment on the ground that he wants to place on record a compromise, which has been entered into between the parties, on the basis of which, the appellant does not intend to pursue the matter any further.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 2.3.2016.”

Thereafter, numerous opportunities were granted to the appellant but copy of compromise has not been placed on record so far. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that it is a fact that parties have already arrived at an amicable settlement. In this view of the matter, learned counsel for the appellant seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present regular second appeal, however, with liberty to the appellant to get it revived, if necessity arises.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdraw, with liberty as prayed for.
