AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

After arguing for some time counsel for the appellant states that he would not press this appeal on merits but he may be given 6 months time to remove the saw machine, drill machine and randa machine and it be clarified that he would be allowed to work with his hand tools. Counsel for the respondents has also very fairly accepted this offer.

In the circumstances, let the appellant file an undertaking within a period of 1 month before the Executing Court to the effect that he will remove the above said three machines within a period of six months.

In view of the statement made by the appellant, the appeal stands dismissed with the above observation.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
