This is an application for condonation of 156 days delay in refiling the appeal.

For the reasons recorded in the application, the same is allowed and delay of 156 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

Main Case

This appeal has been filed against the concurrent judgments of the Courts below dismissing the suit filed by the appellant. The appellant was appointed as a Cook with the respondent-Food Craft Institute but his services were terminated during the period of probation which is subject matter of this appeal. The only argument raised by the learned counsel is that no notice was given to the appellant. He however, is not in a position to deny that as per the

terms of the employment Contract there is no requirement of issuing of notice if the service is to be terminated during probation.

In the circumstances, no fault can be found in the judgments of the Courts below.

Consequently, the appeal stands dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.M, if any, also stand disposed of.
