Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks the concession of the grant of anticipatory bail in complaint No. 769, dated 16.11.2009, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, pending before the Court of JMIC, Gurgaon.

On 15.01.2013, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court with a further direction to the trial Court to admit the petitioner on bail on furnishing his bail bonds/surety bonds.

A perusal of order dated 02.04.2013 reveals that the petitioner had complied with the aforesaid directions.

The present petition is for the grant of anticipatory bail in a complaint case lodged by respondent No. 1, who as per the office report, was duly served through his son. However, there is no appearance on his behalf.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 15.01.2013 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
