In view of the above-said common stand taken by both the parties, instant appeal is disposed of in terms of the settlement/compromise dated 06.04.2017. It goes without saying that the parties to the settlement/compromise shall remain bound by the terms & conditions thereof. Should there be any confusion in this regard, it is directed that the settlement/compromise dated 06.04.2017 shall form part of the decree.
