When this case came up for hearing on 13.02.2017, following order was passed by this Court: -

“Called twice. Neither anybody has come present to argue this appeal nor any request for pass over has been made.

One last and final opportunity is granted to learned counsel for the appellants to argue the case, because this is the 4th date in a row and nobody seems to be interested in arguing the appeal.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 11.05.2017.”

It is pertinent to note here that none appeared on 19.01.2017 and 02.02.2017 on behalf of the appellants. Similar is the position today. Case has been called twice. Neither any request for pass over has been made nor anybody has come present on behalf of the appellants to press the present appeal. It seems that the appellants are no more interested in pursuing the present appeal.

In the circumstances noticed hereinabove, this Court is left with no other option except to dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
