The plaintiffs/appellants have lost in both the courts below against the Gram Panchayat, defendant. The courts below have refused to grant permanent injunction restraining the Gram Panchayat from interfering in the peaceful possession of the plaintiffs over an agricultural land described in the head note of the plaint. Meanwhile, the Gram Panchayat filed an application under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands Act, 1964 for eviction of the plaintiffs from the property in dispute and the Gram Panchayat has remained successful and eviction order has been passed against the plaintiffs which renders this second appeal infructuous.

This appeal is disposed of as having become infructuous. In view of this position, no orders are required to be passed in the Miscellaneous applications which stand disposed of.
