Accordingly, legal representatives of late Sara, Sheela, Jai Bhagwan, Raj Kishan, Savitri Devi and Shish Ram (being missing for 45 years), who are stated to have died on 19.12.2013, 03.04.2005, 26.06.2017, 22.07.2012 and 21.07.2014, respectively, as depicted in the application are brought on record for the purpose of pursuing the present appeal only. It is clarified that this order shall have no bearing if any dispute qua the Mutation No.3081 dated 02.06.2008, is pending before any Court.
