This appeal has been filed against the concurrent judgments of the Courts below dismissing the suit of the appellant challenging two corrections in fard badar incorporated in the Jamabandies for the years 1987-88 and 2003-04.

The Courts below found that the respondent had purchased share in the land in dispute by two sale deeds, mutation on the basis of which was also sanctioned, but while preparing the jamabandies the effect of the mutation was not incorporated. Interestingly it was not the case of the appellant that no sale deeds had taken place or that there was any defect in the title of the respondent. It was in these circumstances that the Courts

below held that fard badar had been made only to correct the clerical

mistake as per para 7.29 & 30 of the Punjab Land Record Manual which deal with correction of clerical mistake in revenue record.

Counsel has not been able to show how these findings are flawed.

Appeal is dismissed. No costs.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
