Prayer in this application filed under Section 151 CPC is for placing on record the settlement/compromise dated 29.09.2016 as Annexure A-3.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and the compromise dated 29.09.2016 (Annexure A-3) is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

The appellant-plaintiff has filed the present regular second appeal against the judgment and decree dated 04.09.2013 passed by learned

Additional District Judge, Patiala, whereby her appeal filed against the judgment and decree dated 02.02.2012 passed by learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Nabha, was dismissed.

The appellant-plaintiff has filed a suit for declaration and permanent injunction to the effect that she is exclusive owner in possession of the land measuring 77 Bighas 3 Biswas fully detailed in the plaint. She has also challenged the mutation No.1967 dated 19.01.2006 entered in the name of the respondents-defendants. The said suit was dismissed as the plaintiff has failed to prove that she is legally wedded wife of Jarnail Singh (deceased) and, therefore, entitled to inherit his property.

Learned counsel for the appellant-plaintiff has contended that during pendency of the present appeal, the matter has been compromised between the parties. In support of his contention, he has annexed the compromise dated 29.09.2016 as Annexure A-3. He states that in view of the compromise so arrived at between the parties, he does not press this appeal and the same may be disposed of in terms of compromise (Annexure A-3).

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from the respondents, who are present in the Court, admits the very factum of compromise so entered between the parties and states that he has no objection if the present appeal is disposed of in terms of compromise (Annexure A-3).

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, the present regular second appeal is disposed of in terms of compromise dated 29.09.2016 (Annexure A-3) as entered between the parties. Accordingly, the

compromise (Annexure A-3) be made part of the record. Decree sheet be prepared accordingly.
