This appeal has been filed against the concurrent judgments of the Courts below decreeing the suit of the respondent by which he had prayed for declaration that the appellants had no power to disconnect and transfer the water & sewerage connection situated at the house of the respondent.

The case of the appellants was that the dues of the predecessor-in-interest of the respondent were existing and in default of the payment thereof it had the right to disconnect the water and sewerage connection. The respondent was able to show to the Courts that under the By-laws the connection could not be transferred unless all the previous dues have been cleared and that the appellants were not able to show any material as to how the connection was transferred without following this mandatory provision.

Counsel for the appellants has not been able to show how this finding is flawed.

Appeal is dismissed. No costs.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
