For the reasons mentioned in the application, delay of 10 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

Application stands disposed of.

No ground for interference is made out against the elaborate and well reasoned judgment and order passed by the learned District Judge, Yamunanagar in first appeal, setting aside the judgment of the trial Court. The Judge has considered every aspect of the enquiry proceedings threadbare and has found the enquiry report to be the work of a 'despot' with the pre-occupied and pre-determined mind to fix the respondent employee without there being any probative evidence against him to bring home the charge, the value of which is zilch. I concur wholeheartedly with the findings recorded in the judgment of reversal.

No ground for interference is made out in second appeal as

no question of law arises, much less substantial or patent. Dismissed.
