This is an application for condonation of delay of 12 days in re-filing the present regular second appeal.

This is an application under Order 23 Rule 3 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure for disposing of the appeal in terms of the accompanying compromise dated 4.11.2015 (Annexure AX-1), as per which it has been agreed between the parties that the judgment and decree of the trial Court be restored and that of the Appellate Court be set aside. By the trial Court decree the appellants and respondents No. 2, 3 and 4 become the owners of the property in dispute on behalf of sole contesting respondent No.1-Sohan Lal and respondent No.2 (a) who are duly identified by their Counsel Mr.

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Prateek Pandit, Advocate. He also placed on record Special Power of Attorney executed by respondents No. 1- (b), (c) and (d). Learned counsel for the respondents states that he has no objection if the suit passed by the trial Court is restored.

Ordered accordingly. Application stands allowed. The judgment of the Appellate Court is set aside.

Appeal stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stand disposed of.
