During the course of arguments in the present appeal, it has transpired that the respondent had also filed a suit for taking possession from the present appellant through lawful means. That suit stands decreed. Therefore, the counsel for the respondent submits that there is no question of taking possession forcibly from the present appellant. Process of taking possession shall be completed only through the process of law, as prescribed.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the appellant, on instructions from his client, submits that he does not want to press the present appeal.
