On the joint request made by learned counsel for the parties, date of hearing of the appeal is ordered to be preponed from 14.09.2017 to today. Appeal is taken on board for final disposal.

Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that during pendency of the present appeal, parties have arrived at an amicable settlement by way of compromise dated 23.02.2017 (Annexure P-3). They further pray that let the regular second appeal be disposed of, in terms of the compromise arrived at between the parties and the learned executing Court may be directed to execute the decree, strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions of the compromise (Annexure P-3).

In view of the abovesaid joint and fair statement made by learned counsel for the parties, CM No.9983-C of 2017 is allowed, for the reasons

stated therein. Regular second appeal is ordered to be disposed of, in terms of the compromise (Annexure P-3).

Should there be any confusion in this regard, it is directed that the compromise (Annexure P-3) shall form part of the decree. Learned executing Court is also directed to ensure execution of the decree, strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions of the compromise (Annexure P-3).

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, civil miscellaneous application as well as the appeal stand disposed of.
