CM No.1586-CI of 2017

This is an application seeking condonation of delay of 120 days in re-filing the accompanying appeal.

For the reasons set out in the application, that is duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed. Consequently, delay of 120 days in re-filing the appeal is condoned.

CM No.1587-CI of 2017

This is an application seeking condonation of delay of 127 days in filing the accompanying appeal.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Shivendra Swaroop, AAG Haryana, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

For the reasons set out in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed. Consequently, delay of 127 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

CM No.1588-CI of 2017

For the reasons set out in the application, that is duly supported by an affidavit, same is allowed, subject to all just exceptions. Consequently, legal representatives of deceased Maha Devi-appellant No.4, who is stated to have died on 11.01.2013, during the pendency of the Reference, are granted leave to institute and maintain the accompanying appeal.

CM stands disposed of.

CM No.1589-CI of 2017

For the reasons set out in the application, that is duly supported by an affidavit, same is allowed, subject to all just exceptions. Consequently, legal representatives of deceased Ram Phal-appellant No.2, who is stated to have died on 01.12.2011, as depicted in para No.2 of the application, are brought on record, for the purpose of pursuing the appeal only.

CM stands disposed of.

RFA No.566 of 2017

Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that the matter in issue is squarely covered by an order/judgement dated 27.05.2016, rendered by this Court in **RFA No.5316 of 2014** titled “Pushpender Kumar and others vs. State of Haryana and another”, vide which, in the appeals arising out of the same acquisition, this Court had enhanced the compensation awarded to the landowners. Thus, the present appeal be also disposed of in terms thereof.
