Applicant-wife, by way of instant transfer application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, seeks transfer of a petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as Jasdeep Dulkoan @ Jasdeep Singh Dulkoan Vs. Anju Dulkoan filed by the respondent-husband from SBS Nagar to Ludhiana.

Notice of motion was issued and in the meantime, further proceedings before the learned Court at SBS Nagar were stayed.
