This is an application for condonation of delay of 1711 days in filing the accompanying appeal. All what has been urged by the learned counsel for the applicant is that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the judgment, dated 4.2.2016, rendered by this court in RFA No.266 of 2012 (Joginder Singh Tokash Vs. State of Haryana and others), and other connected matters, vide which, the compensation awarded to the claimants/landowners was enhanced by this Court.

Notice in the application.

Mr. Yogesh Chaudhary, Advocate for respondent No.1 and Ms. Safia Gupta, AAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3.

The factual position, as set out above, is not disputed by learned counsel for the respondents.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the records.

In the wake of the decisions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Imrat Lal and others v. Land Acquisition Collector and others*, 2015(2) RCR (Civil) 437 and *Dhiraj Singh (D) Tr. LRs. v. Haryana State and others*, 2015 (2) RCR (Civil) 507, delay of 1711 days in filing the accompanying appeal is condoned. However, to balance the equities, for the period of delay in filing the appeal the applicant shall not be entitled to any interest on the enhanced compensation.

CM stands disposed of.

CM No-226-227-CI-2017

For the reasons set out in the applications, which are duly supported by an affidavit, the same are allowed subject to all just exceptions. Consequently, the LRs of late Smt.Shanti and Smt.Anita who expired on 01.12.2015 and 21.02.2014 respectively as depicted in para 3 of the applications, are brought on record for the purpose of pursuing the present appeal only.
