Applicant-wife, by way of instant transfer application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure (for short 'CPC'), seeks transfer of the divorce petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 ('the Act' for short) titled as Sukhwinderpal Singh Vs. Harveen Kaur filed by respondent-husband from Ludhiana to Jalandhar.

Notice of motion was issued and the learned Court below was directed to adjourn the case beyond the date fixed before this Court.

When the case came up for hearing on 24.01.2017, learned counsel for the applicant sought time to get instructions, whether the case should be transferred from Ludhiana to any other place except Jalandhar.

In compliance of the abovesaid order passed by this Court, learned counsel for the applicant submits that let the case be transferred from

Ludhiana to Kapurthala, instead of Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the respondent also fairly states that the respondent-husband has also no objection in case his divorce petition is transferred from Ludhiana to Kapurthala.

In view of the abovesaid respective fair statements made by learned counsel for the parties, present transfer application is allowed.

Consequently, learned District Judge, Ludhiana is directed to send complete record of the divorce petition filed by the respondent-husband titled as Sukhwinderpal Singh Vs. Harveen Kaur, to the learned District Judge, Kapurthala, at an early date but in any case within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The learned District Judge, Kapurthala is also directed either to decide the case himself or assign it to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction, for an early decision, in accordance with law.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present transfer application stands disposed of, however, with no order as to costs.
