When the case came up for hearing on 8.3.2017, following order was passed by this Court:-

“As per office report dated 04.03.2017, dasti notice received back with the report that the address was found incomplete. Notice issued to the respondent for service through his counsel before the learned trial Court has not been received back served or otherwise. Learned counsel for the applicant is not having any instructions in this regard.

In view of the above, one last and final opportunity is granted to the applicant to serve the respondent by way of dasti process as well as through his counsel before the learned trial Court, in addition to ordinary process.

On filing the latest and complete address of counsel of the respondent before the learned trial Court within a period of one week from today, let fresh notice be issued to the respondent for 18.04.2017.

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As per office report dated 7.4.2017, no correct or fresh address was supplied by the applicant, because of which notice could not be issued. Neither anybody has come present on behalf of the applicant to press this transfer application, nor any request for pass over has been made.

In view of the above, it seems that applicant is no more interested in pursuing the present transfer application and the same is hereby dismissed for non prosecution, however, granting liberty to the applicant to get it revived within a period of one month from today, if necessity arises.
