Applicant, by way of instant transfer application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure (for short 'CPC'), seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as Parminderjit Singh Vs. Jaspreet Kaur, filed by respondent-husband from Mohali to Amritsar.

Notice of motion was issued and learned court below was directed to adjourn the matter beyond the date fixed before this Court. Thereafter, numerous orders including the orders dated 29.11.2016, 16.2.2017 and 3.3.2017 would show that despite having been granted many opportunities including last and final opportunity to serve the respondent by way of dasti process as well as through his counsel before the learned court below, applicant has not shown any interest in effecting the service on the respondent.

Learned counsel for the applicant submits that he has got no instructions and in the absence of any appropriate instructions, he is unable to comply with the orders passed by this Court.

In view of the above, the instant transfer application is dismissed for non-compliance of the above-said numerous orders passed by this Court.
