Applicant-wife, by way of instant transfer application under Section 24 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, seeks transfer of a petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as Baljeet Bassi Vs. Mrs. Sameep filed by the respondent-husband from Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur to Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the respondent-husband has pointed out that applicant-wife used to appear before the learned Court at Dasuya, but then she stopped appearing and was proceeded against ex-parte, vide order dated 18.05.2016.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the applicant-wife seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present transfer application to enable the applicant-wife to seek setting aside of ex-parte order dated 18.05.2016 passed by the learned Court at Dasuya and with liberty to file fresh transfer application, if necessity arises.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.
