Learned counsel for the appellant, at the very outset, fairly states that he has got the clear instructions to say that the appellant-defendant/judgment-debtor, as a matter of fact, is not feeling aggrieved against the impugned judgments and decrees and he wants to obey the impugned decrees as they are, however, he only seeks some reasonable time to pay the money as per the impugned decrees. He further submits that marriage of son of the appellant is fixed for 28.04.2017.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the appellant seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present appeal with liberty to the appellant to move the appropriate application before the learned executing Court, making the prayer for granting reasonable time, so as to enable the appellant to obey the impugned decrees in its true letter and spirit.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.
