Applicant-wife, by way of instant transfer application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, seeks transfer of a petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 ('the HM Act' for short) bearing HMA No.177 of 2016, from Rupnagar to Fatehgarh Sahib.

Notice of motion was issued.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the respondent, at the very outset, fairly states that he has got the clear instructions to say that respondent would have no objection in case the present transfer application is accepted and the above-said petition under Section 9 of the HM Act is ordered to be transferred from Rupnagar to Fatehgarh Sahib.

In view of the above-said fair statement made by the learned counsel for the respondent, the instant transfer application deserves to be accepted and the same is hereby allowed.

Consequently, learned District Judge, Rupnagar, is directed to send complete record of the above-said case bearing HMA No.177 of 2016 to the learned District Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib, at an early date and in any case within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Learned District Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib, is also directed either to decide the case herself or assign it to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction for its early decision, in accordance with law.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present transfer application stands disposed of.
