Learned counsel for the respondent, at the very outset, fairly states that since during pendency of the present transfer application, parties have amicably resolved the matter and as a consequence thereof, they have filed a petition for mutual divorce at Rewari, present transfer application does not survive any further and may be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous. He also undertakes on behalf of respondent-husband to withdraw his petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, pending at Sunam District Sangrur, within a period of one week from today.

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The abovesaid statement made by learned counsel for the respondent also satisfies learned counsel for the applicant.

In view of the above, present transfer application is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
