Applicant, by way of instant transfer application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure (for short 'CPC'), seeks transfer of Civil Suit No.358/2015 titled as Rajinder Singh and others Vs. Amarjit Kumar filed by the respondents from Bathinda to any other place outside District Bathinda.

Notice of motion was issued. Reply has been filed.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that instead of transferring the abovesaid civil suit out of District Bathinda, let the same be transferred to Talwandi Sabo, which is a sub division of District Bathinda.

In view of the abovesaid common and fair stand taken on behalf of the parties, instant transfer application is allowed, so as to secure the ends of justice.

Consequently, the learned District Judge, Bathinda is directed to assign the abovesaid civil suit to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction at Talwandi Sabo, which is a sub division of District Bathinda itself, for its early decision, in accordance with law.

As the learned counsel for the parties have apprised this Court that the next date of hearing before the learned trial Court is 17.07.2017, let the abovesaid civil suit be assigned to the learned Court at Talwandi Sabo within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Disposed of, accordingly.
