HARI PAL VERMA J, (Oral):

Appellant-defendant has filed the present regular second appeal against judgment and decree dated 22.12.2016 passed by District Judge, Jhajjar, whereby, learned lower Appellate Court has partly modified the judgment and decree dated 2.12.2015 passed by Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Jhajjar, directing the appellant-defendant to repay the amount of Rs.13,00,000/- within four months to the respondent-plaintiff along with interest @ 9% per annum from 12.1.2011 till its actual realization.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that he has got instructions from his client to state that the appellant is ready to satisfy the decree passed by the lower Appellate Court within four weeks from today.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Madan Gupta, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent and filed his power of attorney in Court, which is taken

on record. He has no objection to the prayer made on behalf of the appellant being accepted.

In view of the categorical statement so made on behalf of the appellant, the present appeal is disposed of and the appellant is granted four weeks time from today to satisfy the decree passed by the lower Appellate Court.

It is made clear that in case the appellant fails to satisfy the decree within four weeks, as submitted by the appellant, the present appeal shall be deemed to have been dismissed without any further order.
