File has been received back from Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court with the report that the parties have amicably settled the matter in dispute and an agreement/written settlement dated 20.03.2017 has been executed between the parties.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that the written settlement bears the signatures of the parties as well as of their counsel and that the settlement had taken place voluntarily and without any pressure from any quarters.

It is also submitted by counsel for the appellants that as per terms and conditions of the settlement, the appellants have already paid the total amount settled between the parties towards full and final satisfaction of claim of the respondent.

Learned counsel for the respondent admits that the claim of the respondent has been satisfied and the amount agreed between the parties has

been received by him. He submits that the instant appeal be disposed of as per the terms of agreement/written settlement dated 20.03.2017.

Learned counsel for the appellants submits that the Court fee paid by the appellants may be refunded to them.

Considering the submissions made by counsel for the parties, the instant appeal is disposed of in terms of the written settlement/agreement dated 20.03.2017. The said written settlement is made part of this order. The parties shall remain bound by the said settlement. The Court fee paid by the appellants in filing the Regular Second Appeal be refunded to him.
