Learned counsel for the respondent has filed status report in the Court today and the same is taken on record. A copy, thereof, has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners.

It has been mentioned in the status report that in compliance of directions issued by this Court, out of total 54 petitioners, the cases in respect of ACP of 50 petitioners have already been finalized and ACP scales have been granted to them. The remaining four cases are being examined but due to pendency of departmental proceedings against them, they have not been granted the benefit and their cases will be considered at the earliest.

Learned counsel for the respondent also undertakes to release necessary payments within a period of two weeks.

The contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.

However, in case, the non-compliance of order is there or the

undertaking is not complied with, the petitioners are at liberty to move an application for revival of contempt petition. The application is not required to be moved for revival in case of remaining four petitioners whose cases have not been decided as yet.
