The appellants/plaintiffs i.e. Harnam Singh and Gurnam Singh, sons of Ghansham are in second appeal against the concurrent judgments and decrees passed by both the Courts below, whereby their suit for permanent injunction for restraining their Cousin-Lakhmi Chand (respondent No.1 herein) from interfering in the peaceful possession of half share of land measuring 2 Kanals and 7 Marlas comprised in the suit land was dismissed and the findings affirmed.

Learned Counsel for the appellants/plaintiffs heard at length.

It is conceded that the plaintiffs have led no evidence at all inspite of numerous opportunities and, therefore, the suit was dismissed and the findings affirmed.

In view of the nature of the relief claimed by the plaintiffs and the findings recorded, no substantial question of law is involved.

Accordingly, the present appeal is dismissed.
