Whether or not Sarwan Singh married the plaintiff, is a pure question of fact which has been determined by two Courts concurrently against the plaintiff-appellant. The view is endorsed by this Court noticing from the judgment that the plaintiff failed to examine any witness who had attended her marriage ceremony with Sarwan Singh. Sarwan Singh was a Government employee who died and as against whose service benefits the plaintiff had approached Court claiming the dues, but she was not the nominee of late Sarwan Singh in the records of the department.

No ground is made out for review.

The review application stands dismissed.
