Learned counsel for respondents No.1 & 2 submitted that an application has been filed in the Registry, wherein, 'No Objection Certificate' along with the short reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Sanjeev Kumar s/o Sh. Sham Lal, Authorized Officer, M/s Indiabulls Housing Finance Ltd. has been appended.

It has been averred therein that 'No Objection Certificate' for release and registration of property bearing H.No. 210, Focal Point, Rajpura, Patiala (Punjab) has been issued by M/s Indiabulls Housing Finance Limited in favour of the petitioner. A copy of the 'No Objection Certificate' has also been addressed to the Estate Officer, Punjab Urban Development Authority, Patiala, for transferring the property in the name of the subsequent vendee i.e. Mr. Siddharath Verma.

However, a copy of the aforesaid short reply along with 'No Objection Certificate' has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. Office to tag the same at the appropriate place.

A copy thereof has been handed over to the learned counsel for the execution-petitioner.

In view of the above, it was submitted that since the order dated 12.04.2016, passed by this Court in CWP No.15437 of 2015, titled as "Siddharath Verma Vs. Authorized Officer, Indiabulls Housing

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Finance Limited and others” has been complied with and the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed, therefore, the present execution-application has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.
