Learned counsel for the applicants submitted that issue raised in the suit filed by the applicants/appellants was regarding share in the property left by Durga Dass (deceased), who was survived by two sons, namely, Malkiat Singh and Ajit Singh and family of pre-deceased son Parkash Chand. As the dispute had been settled, though not reduced into writing, on instructions from applicants/appellants, the appeal was withdrawn. However, later on the contesting respondents backed out from the settlement. The prayer is that the appeal may be heard on merits.

Considering the statement made by learned counsel for the applicant, order dated 17.07.2015 permitting the applicants/appellants to withdraw the present appeal in view of the compromise between the parties is recalled and the appeal is restored to its original number.
