The present review petition under Order 47 Rule 1 read with Section 114 of the Code of Civil Procedure read with Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for reviewing the judgment dated 30.4.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no FIR is pending against the petitioner and only a departmental inquiry was pending at the relevant time. He further submits that the petitioner is entitled to full pension with interest from 1.4.2006 to 31.8.2007.

Heard.

The matter was decided in the presence of the counsel for the petitioner. Even in the reply, it has been specifically mentioned that FIR/ DDR is pending against the petitioner. However, the petitioner was given liberty that in case, he is acquitted in the FIR, he can raise his claim against respondent Nos. 1 and 2.

No case for review of the judgment dated 30.4.2015 is made out and as such, the present review petition is dismissed being devoid of merit.
