
Sandeep vs. State of Haryana

This petition had been disposed of vide an order of this Court dated 10.11.2016, directing that if the prosecution did not conclude its evidence on or before 12.12.2016, the trial Court would release the petitioner on bail on 12.12.2016.

The matter was put up before this Court by the Registry, on 27.01.2017, on a report having been received from the trial Court that since the prosecution did not make any effort to ensure the presence of witnesses in the Court, despite the undertaking given by the Superintendent of Police, Sonapat, to this Court, on affidavit, the petitioner was released on bail on 12.12.2016.

On that date (27.01.2017) the matter had simply been adjourned till today with none having appeared for the petitioner, as obviously he was not aware that the petition, which had been disposed of, would be put up for hearing.

Today learned counsel for the State has produced in Court the judgment of the trial Court dated 28.02.2017, by which the petitioner and his co-accused were given the benefit of doubt and acquitted of the charges framed against them.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions, further submits

that after 12.12.2016 the prosecution witnesses were all duly examined.

Consequently, this petition already having been disposed of, nothing further remains to be done and the file may be consigned to the record room.
