AMIT RAWAL, J.(ORAL)

The review application has been filed at the instance of the review petitioner/respondent/plaintiff seeking review of the order dated 29th September, 2015. He had succeeded in obtaining declaratory decree dated 24th May, 2013, operative part of which already extracted in the order sought to be reviewed. This Court vide order dated 29.09.2015 has set aside the order dated 12.09.2013 whereby a direction was issued to the police to render help to the decree holder for implementation of the decree dated 24.5.2001 and order dated 24.05.2013, though a liberty was granted to both the parties to seek partition in accordance with law.

In my view there is no error apparent on the face of record. No permission of the Court is required. It is statutory right of either of the party i.e. co-sharer to seek partition. No ground is made out for interference.

Resultantly, the review application is dismissed.
