
Asha Rani and others vs. State of Punjab and others

This petition was put up by the Registry of this Court, in view of the fact that vide the order dated 05.11.2014, it was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice got issued by the petitioners, within a specified period, with a further direction that the legal notice would be decided in the light of the order passed in COCP No. 2059 of 2012, decided on 16.10.2014 (as shown in the last line of the said order dated 05.11.2014).

As per note of the Registry, COCP No. 2059 of 2012, was actually dismissed on 11.05.2015 and was not disposed of on 16.10.2014.

Consequently, learned counsel for the petitioner, vide an order dated 23.05.2017, had been asked to provide the correct COCP number and the correct date of decision of the case, in the light of which the respondents were directed to decide the legal notice issued on behalf of the petitioners on 10.10.2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the correct number is COCP No. 3059 of 2012, which is seen to have been decided along with a large number of other connected petitions on 16.10.2014, as per the judgment produced in Court today.

Consequently, the order passed in the present petition on 05.11.2014, is ordered to be corrected to show in the last line thereof, that

the legal notice to be decided by the respondents would be in the light of the judgment of this Court passed in COCP No. 3059 of 2012, decided on 16.10.2014, along with the other connected matters.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that actually an order deciding the legal notice had already been passed by the respondents, in the light of the judgment passed in COCP No. 3059 of 2012 itself.

However, since the record needs to be corrected, the correction be carried out in the last line of the order dated 05.11.2014.
