On 21.04.2017 it was stated that the contempt proceedings had come to an end in terms of the final order passed by the Bench on 20.11.2014. It was also recorded that during hearing on 26.09.2014, the Bench had ordered that the statements recorded by the learned District Judge and the order produced before the Executing Court shall be kept in safe custody by the Registrar(Judicial).

Registry has also sought clarification in the background of the dismissal of the contempt petition.

As per office report, it is stated that the statements recorded by learned District Judge, Hoshiarpur and the order produced before the Executing Court, Dasuya are still lying in the safe custody of the Registrar (Judicial).
