Amandeep Kaur, applicant-wife prays for transfer of petition (HMA 88 of 2017 titled Ravinder Pal Singh v. Amandeep Kaur) filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act 1955 by the respondent-husband, pending in the Court of District Judge (Family Court), Karnal to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Kaithal.

Counsel for the applicant would submit that due to marital disharmony between the parties, three proceedings initiated on behalf of the applicant-wife are pending in the Court at Guhla, District Kaithal. There is a female child born out of the wedlock on 17.11.2014 and she is residing with the applicant-mother. The applicant has to change three buses for going from her village Teh Butana, Tehsil Guhla, District Kaithal to Karnal, therefore, the petition filed by the respondent-husband may be transferred to

a Court of competent jurisdiction at Kaithal.

Counsel for the respondent, on the other hand, would submit that father of the respondent has been suffering because of paralytic attack and his mother has age related problems, causing inconvenience for the respondent-husband to attend to the proceedings pending at Guhla, District Kaithal.

After making submissions, counsel for the parties have arrived at a consensus that all the cases pending in the Court(s) at Guhla as well as the present petition may be transferred to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Kaithal.

In view of the above, the present petition is withdrawn from the Court of District Judge (Family Court), Karnal and transferred to the Court of District Judge, Kaithal. The District Judge, Kaithal is directed to transfer three cases namely application under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, complaint No. 13/2016 filed under Section 12 of the **Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005** and a criminal case under Sections 323, 406, 498-A and 506 of India Penal Code, pending in the Court (s) at Guhla to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Kaithal.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
