Prayer in this application is for transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the respondent-husband HMA case No.43/2017 titled **Amit Tayagi Vs. Sujata** pending in the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Karnal to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Panipat.

Counsel for the applicant has submitted that three litigations initiated at the instance of the applicant are pending in the Courts at Panipat and the respondent is attending to the proceedings before the Courts concerned, therefore, no inconvenience would be caused to the respondent in case the petition filed by him seeking decree of divorce is transferred to a competent Court at Panipat.

Respondent has not caused appearance to controvert the averments raised in the application.

In view of the above, petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, HMA case No.43/2017 titled **Amit Tayagi Vs. Sujata** is withdrawn from the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Karnal and is

transferred to the Court of District Judge, Panipat. The District Judge, Panipat may keep the petition on its board or assign it to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Panipat. The Court seized of the matter would try to accommodate the respondent by fixing the case on a date on which he has to appear in the criminal proceedings pertaining to FIR No.1103 dated 08.11.2014.
