REKHA MITTAL, J.

The applicant prays for transfer of the petition “Jagsir Singh Vs. Mandeep Kaur” under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the court of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Gidderbaha to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Moga.

It is submitted that the applicant is a resident of village Marri Mustaffa, Tehsil Baghapurana, District Moga, which is at a distance of more than 100 kilometres from Gidderbaha. The applicant has filed application under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and the same is pending in the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Moga. It is further submitted that the applicant has no source of income and till date, the respondent-husband has not provided for maintenance to the applicant since the time they are residing separately.

The respondent did not cause appearance despite service. There is no counter to the averments raised in the application.

Keeping in view the above, the petition titled “Jagsir Singh

Versus Mandeep Kaur” is withdrawn from the Court of Additional Civil

Judge, Gidderbaha and transferred to the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Moga for further proceedings, in accordance with law.

With the aforesaid observations, the petition stands disposed of.
