Counsel for the respondent would state that the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short, HMA) pending in the Court at Amritsar has since been dismissed for non-prosecution, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous. He has further informed that petition filed by the applicant under Section 125 Cr.P.C. which was pending in the Court at SBS Nagar has been disposed of.

Counsel for the applicant would state that the petition under Section 13 HMA filed by the respondent has been dismissed for non-prosecution on 20.09.2017 and the respondent may file an application for seeking its restoration.

In view of the above, the present application is disposed of having been rendered infructuous, at this stage, but without prejudice to right of the applicant to seek its revival in case the petition filed by the respondent under Section 13 HMA is restored on the Board of the Court at Amritsar.
